- South West in Bloom: Paul Bourton has requested planting a container near his premises to match the BID colour and planting scheme, this was agreed. WRP are using the buckets for Christmas displays. Final plans and costings to be finalised for discussion in January.
- **Cost Savings:** JK outlined that he had met with Cornwall Council and was investigating working together with other Cornish BIDs.
- Security, Cleanliness and Shopwatch Radio: Over 40 radios have been installed and had already proven useful. It was agreed to review progress and discuss the BID Levy Payer rebate scheme and timings at the next meeting.
- **Premises- Appearance and Occupation:** Hayley reported that a very useful meeting of this group has taken place and a list of key target retailers was being drawn up with a view to written approaches in 2016.
- 4. BID Manager Update: All points had already been covered.

5. Feedback from Various Meetings:

JK updated the meeting regarding a meeting he had attaneded at Eden called "Connecting Cornwall". He met a number of senior managers from the local press who confirmed that they would help to throw a more positive light on St Austell during 2016.

JK updated that we remain in dialogue with Cornwall Council regarding Coach Parking facilities in the Town Centre and this was in conjunction with the Town Council, CoC and local MPs office. There is another meeting scheduled for December.

6. BID Finances:

Giles distributed the Management Accounts for 8 months to the 30th November 2015 which continue to run in line with expectations. It was agreed to review the Shopwatch radio rebate timing in January.
