**South West in Bloom**: Judges have visited, one of them was particularly eco friendly, good comments regarding the planting schemes and baskets.

**Security and StoreNet Radio**: Begging has reduced as the Safer St Austell working as homed some offenders. Reporting remains a priority and the Security Patrols are having a positive effect. Police and Crime Commissioner visit on15th August. Safer St Austell leaflet finished and will be distributed.

**Street Cleaning and Appearance**: BID and Town Council will continue to share extra cleans.

Premises – Appearance and Occupation: No update.

BID2 Re-Elections Progress: Surveys responses show a 78% yes indication. The working group continue to draft the final business plan. The letters requesting the ballot to the Secretary of State and Cornwall Council have been sent and acknowledged. The new BID area map was reviewed and agreed. A discussion took place about applying an inflationary increase to levy payments. It was agreed via a vote that inflation would not be included. The BID 2 levy would be set at 2%. The summary BID 2 budget was reviewed, discussed and approved. The working group would finalise the process and business plan.
